## Ministry of the Month

### "The Loaves and Fishes Ministry"



Loaves and Fishes is a Soup Kitchen Ministry which is held in a small church located at West Main Street Christian Church. The church has Sunday morning and evening services with midweek a bible study service called "The Master's Table" on Wednesday night. Under the constant and faithful supervision of the Pastor Jeff Douds and Mrs. Dawn Smith, and in

partnership with local churches, the Soup kitchen ministry has been going on every Saturday since 1985.

The WMU of Zion Baptist Church has been assisting in feedings there over the last several years and this year will mark our 5<sup>th</sup> year of Service to the Lord at Loaves and Fishes. The main part of our ministry there is to provide a hot meal that includes a meat, 2-3 vegetables, bread, dessert, and a drink. Condiments, utensils and whatever else is necessary to complete the meal is also provided. Since beginning our ministry there we have endeavored to provide additional needs there at the church. For instance, the WMU remodeled the bathroom, which was in horrible repair, for those coming to eat at the kitchen. Once we begun serving at Laves and Fishes, The WMU realized there were many other needs to be filled at the church, some of those needs included bringing baby food and diapers to those who bring in small children and infants. Supplying coats, gloves, socks, toboggans for those in need during the cold winter months. We also provide hand sanitizer as well. In addition to the hot meal that is served, a bagged meal is provided to each person who comes in to the mission. The bagged meal consist of various non perishable food items such as Vienna sausages. The bagged lunch also has crackers, individual condiments, chips, fruit, puddings, cookies, etc. A witnessing tract is also included in the bag in hopes that as they enjoy the food provided that they will realize from whom it came.

The WMU plans to serve at Loaves and Fishes 4 times throughout 2015. This ministry is not just for members of the WMU, in fact we encourage everyone to come out and help serve and experience this very special ministry.

Loaves and Fishes goal is to feed the hungry, not just food for their bodies, but most importantly to give them food for their souls. As it says in John 6:35 Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life; he who comes to me will not hunger, and he who believes in Me will never thirst."
